

PRIEURÉ SAINT MAURICE



In 1262, Saint Louis founded the priory Saint-Maurice, inside the grounds of the royal castle, in order to house the relics of twenty-four martyrs from the Thebean Legion, companions of Saint Maurice.

From the monastic set of buildings, only the eastern aisle of the *Prieuré Saint-Maurice* remains. The priory had been altered up until the 19th century. On the first floor, the monks' dormitory has been restored.
